Preparation for offering and implementation of SFC's to Latin American countries continues as the research and design of Sustainable Family Communities® has been proven to provide a means for sustainable community, sustainable economy, sustainable food-supply and a sustainable society. Our initial focus was on creating a self-sustaining Orphan Community-Mexico. During the process of doing this we have realized that the sustainable community model is capable of helping families lift themselves out of poverty. Our focus is now two-fold. 1). Helping families to create prosperous communities for themselves and 2). Reducing the number of orphans by first reducing the likelihood of child abandonment to orphanages due to poverty and also by assisting families to adopt children from orphanages.
